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



Chen and Lin decided to warm up last night's dinner. They placed a bowl of rice inside the microwave and pressed the button to start it, but the microwave didn't start at all!


Lin double checked the power point to make sure it was working, while Chen tried pressing the button again, this time a bit harder. Oh no! The microwave still wouldn't start!

When Chen arrived at the home appliances store, there was a huge queue.


"Oh great!" Chen thought rolling his eyes. He hated crowds!

"Okay, can you tell me what happened when you turned it on?" asked the cashier with a frown.



"Would you like a refund or an exchange?" he asked.




Chen was confused as he had never heard these words before.

"Refund? Exchange? What is the difference?" he thought.


Chen decided that he better check with the cashier,

"According to our store policy, if you buy a faulty product, you can choose between a refund or an exchange," he added.






